1. Cottage Grove South Service Center-Park on access road just north of the building which is located at 13000 Ravine Parkway So., Cottage Grove

2. Ravine Parkway construction, Cottage Grove

We will walk to this site which is about a block or two away from the Service Center where we will hear about the project and discuss staging and sequencing. We will also see practices such as temporary stabilization and temporary sediment basins. We will be there while a bridge over the ravine will be under construction.

3. McDonalds Restaurant Commercial Redevelopment, 1759 Weir Dr, Woodbury

We will get into our vehicles and drive about 8 miles to the McDonalds redevelopment site. Discuss redevelopment erosion control and stormwater management issues and the new Triton underground stormwater storage system installation (it may be under construction during the tour).
