The St. Croix River Crossing project remained committed to minimizing environmental impacts to the St. Croix River Valley throughout the 5 year construction timeframe. With over 500 construction workers, and numerous activities occurring simultaneously, this commitment became challenging. It required efforts of the entire construction team to remain diligent.

Our boat tour will get up close and look at details of this bridge:

- ◆ The 5 critical river piers.
- ◆ Nearly 1 mile in length (5,074 feet) this bridge will be towering above our tour boat almost 150 feet.
- ◆ A look at the almost 100 precast segments and over 139,219 cubic yards (almost 564 million pounds) of concrete that was used to build a landmark for years to come

The tour will close with strategies the participants can use to secure environmental compliance on their next construction project – regardless of the size or the location.
